Camelback Academy is in their <u>7th year</u> of **Project CHILD**. They have implemented many great things to ensure the most successful use of

the **CHILD** model. Their culture is grounded on respect and commitment and a very tight knit group of people working towards one goal.

They have 2-3 **CHILD** coaches within the school at a time to help manage, observe and ensure the authenticity of the model is being done successfully in each classroom.

All of the students in grades 3-5 are receiving 30 minutes of intensive interventions each day in math, phonological awareness and vocabulary.

The middle school has implemented a full **STEAM** (A represents Agriculture) program this year including grades 6th, 7th, and 8th. What a great way to engage these young students.

They also have Academic Parent Teacher Team (APTT) nights that have had up to 250 parents in attendance! Parents have the opportunity to visit each of their child's teachers and the teachers teach the parents with hands on demonstrations on how to best support their children at home. It really fosters that school to home connection and opens the communication between parent and teacher as well.
